Advance Beneficiary Notice Refraction Billing Policy

A refraction is conducted to measure the strength of the prescription for your glasses. A refraction is also an important tool that aids in the diagnosis and treatment of many eye conditions.

However, most insurers, including Medicare, classify this as a “Non-Covered” Service and require that patients be responsible for payment. Federal guidelines require that refractions be billed separately for all patients.

Our staff is expected to collect payment for refractions, currently \$30.00, on the day of service. This is in addition to any co-pay, deductible or other non-covered service charge you may have.
